RE: Shelf Stability and Expiration of SaniZide Pro 1® Surface Disinfectant formula

Safetec's SaniZide Pro 1® Surface Disinfectant liquid formulation will remain stable when stored in an approved container under the correct conditions and is not required to have expiration dating. Our SaniZide Pro 1® Surface Disinfectant liquid formulation has been assessed to be stable out to three years and is best if used within three years of the date of manufacturing.

In the "Storage and Disposal" section of the label on each container and the Handling and Storage section of the SDS sheet, specific directions are provided regarding storage for optimal performance of the product.

For safe storage, please adhere to the following conditions:

- Store locked up.
- Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame.
- Prevent electrostatic charge build-up by using common bonding and grounding techniques.
- Avoid spark promoters.
- Eliminate sources of ignition.
- Ground/bond container and equipment.
- Store in a closed container away from incompatible materials.
- Store in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight.
- Store in a well-ventilated place.
- Keep out of reach of children.

Additionally, when storing SaniZide Pro 1®, follow pesticide storage guidelines, storing it in the original container and protecting it from extreme heat or cold.

It is ultimately the responsibility of the customer to determine whether their inventory of SaniZide Pro 1® liquid formulation has been stored in accordance with the recommended conditions for safe storage and efficacy as outlined in our guidelines.

RE: Clarification Regarding the Co-mixing (Topping off) of SaniZide Pro 1® Disinfectant Cleaning Solution (EPA Reg. No. 88494-3-67161) Relative to Batch/Lot Numbers and Expiration Dates

The US EPA regulates the labeling and use of disinfectants used in the United States. Approved disinfectant product labels display an EPA Registration Number indicating that the product is approved for sale and use in the United States as well as EPA approval of the claims printed on the label. Also displayed on the container label is an Establishment Number that indicates the origin of the production facility as well as indicating the EPA's approval to produce the product at that facility. In addition, all of the fifty states require approval of disinfectants used in that state. It is a violation of federal law to use a product inconsistent with its labeled instructions.

In regards to the SaniZide Pro 1® Disinfectant: A batch/ lot number appears on the neck of each container or in some cases on the bottom of the container. The batch/ lot number indicates the specific product history including the date of production.

SaniZide Pro 1® is classified as a stable chemistry with both "accelerated and true time stability studies" that substantiate this product remains stable when stored in an approved container. Because it remains stable it does not display an expiration date.
